

Export Policy

Falmat Inc. is in the business of manufacture and sale of bulk cable and cable assemblies. Some of these items are controlled by the International Traffic in Arms regulations (ITAR). Some of these items are controlled by the Export Administration Regulations (EAR). As a global company which operates in the United States, Falmat is governed by these U.S. export control rules.

It is a Falmat, Inc. company policy that all employees comply with all United States export policies and regulations. Under no circumstances will exports be made contrary to U.S. export regulations by any individual operating on behalf of Falmat, Inc.

Employees and contracted representatives of Falmat, Inc. outside the United States may not re-export any controlled item unless appropriate authorization has been obtained. This includes any foreign made items that are subject to national security controls of the United States.

Falmat, Inc. has developed an internal procedure (FWI-Export Restrictions) as a guide for employees involved in the sale and export of these items. It is a Falmat, Inc. company policy that all employees comply with this procedure.
